- 3. To keep things short, sharp and smooth our learning schedule will be from 9am-12pm and teachers will be available to answer any clarifications regarding learning between these hours Monday to Friday.

- 5. With such short notice we weren't able to hand out devices or hard packs to students in order to support distance learning therefore there will not be any ZOOM sessions until devices have been distributed.
- *6.* Your teacher will be in touch tomorrow with some information to support learning from home.
- 7. We are also awaiting Learning Packs from MInistry of Education and will inform you all when they have been sent.
